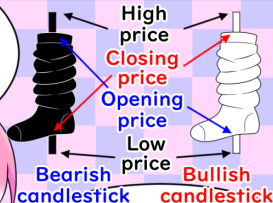


Loose socks are a symbolic item for Japanese high school girls, so it's very kawaii ♥



In this app, white loose socks (baggy socks) show bullish candles where the closing price is higher than the opening price. Conversely, black loose socks show a bearish candlestick where the closing price is lower than the opening price.
